dt.02.05.2025 W.P.No.14108/2025-Request to implement the said
orders of the Hon'ble High Court in its true letter and spirit-Reg.

Ref: Final Orders dt.02.05.2025 W.P.No.14108/2025

1. On instructions of my Client, Smt.Jalapati Varalakshmi, D/o.Galaiah, Age: 47 years, Occ:Unemployee, R/o.Flat No.301, Navya Krishna Homes, Road No.1, R.K.Puram, Kothapeta, Saroor Nagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, this notice is sent to your Hon'ble Authorities requesting to implement the final orders dt.2.5.2025 in WP.No.14108/2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in its true letter and spirit, otherwise, my client will be constrained be to initiate appropriate proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act.
2. My client belongs to OC(W) category. She is local to Nalgonda District. She applied for SGT post notified in DSC-2008 in view of her qualification of B.Ed. Authorities permitted her to write the Written Test with Hall Ticket No.23200114944. In the written test, she secured 63 marks and her rank is 1,138.
3. While such is the state of affairs, the Hon'ble High Court by an interim orders dt.8.2.2024 in W.P.No.18683/2009 & Batch directed the authorities to re-consider the cases of Telangana B.Ed candidates for engaging them as SGTs, on contract basis.

4. To implement the said interim order dt.8.2.2024 of the Hon'ble High Court, authorities issued a Press Note dt.24.9.2024 informing the effected B.Ed candidates to attend certificate verification to be conducted from 27.9.2024 to 5.10.2024.

5. Having seen the said press note, my client approached the authorities and requested them to consider her case for appointment as SGT on contract basis. Then the authorities informed my client stating "DSC-2008 candidates' list prepared on 25.9.2024 does not contain your details as you are a D.Ed qualified candidate". Then, my client shown her B.Ed certificate and requested Respondents to consider her case for appointment as SGT on contract basis by treating her as B.Ed qualified candidate.

6. Then the authorities having verified the record admitted stating "due to typographical mistake, you are shown as D.Ed candidate and as such your details are not shown in the list of effected B.Ed candidates prepared on 25.9.2024". By stating so, the authorities directed my client to make a representation and so that, the said mistake will rectified and her case will be considered for appointment as SGT.

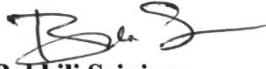
7. Accordingly, my client made representations dt.26.9.2024 requestign your Hon'ble Authorities to include her name in the list of effected B.Ed candidates and consider her case for appointment as SGT. Having received the said representations, the authorities did not consider her case for appointment as SGT though they filled a proforma with her details and in the remarks column made her to write her qualification as B.Ed and took her signature on the said proforma.

8. Then, my client filed the above W.P.No.14108/2025 challenging your action in not considering her case for appointment as SGT on contract basis under DSC-2008 though she secured Rank No.1138 having appointed the candidates, who secured Rank Nos.1140, 1141, 1149, 1158, 1164 & 1166 and also challenging your action in showing her as D.Ed qualified candidate in the General Merit Lit of DSC-2008 instead of showing her as B.Ed qualified candidate and also challenging your action in not including her name in the DSC-2008 Candidates List dt.25.9.2024 prepared by the DEO, Nalgonda, as illegal, unconstitutional, etc.

9. The said Writ Petition was listed for admission on 02.05.2025. Then, the Hon'ble High Court after perusing the record and after hearing submissions made by the learned Counsel for Petitioner and Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for the Respondents was pleased to dispose of the said writ petition as follows:

"6. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, without going into the merits of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 26.09.2024, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with the law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs."

10. Therefore, on instructions of my client, I hereby request your Hon'ble Authorities to implement the said final orders dt.2.5.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in WP/14108/2025 in its true letter and spirit by considering my client's representation dt.26.9.2024 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of four (04) weeks. Any action, which is in contravention of the said orders issued by the Hon'ble High Court, will be amounting to deliberate and wilful violation of the judicial command of the Hon'ble High Court, which attracts the provisions of the Contempt of Courts Act. A copy of the final order dt.2.5.2025 in WP/14108/2025, is enclosed herewith for your perusal and appropriate action.

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE NAMAVARAPU RAJESHWAR RAO

WRIT PETITION No.14108 OF 2025

ORDER:

With the consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself.

2. Heard Mr. Srinivas Bobbili, learned counsel for the petitioner, and the learned Government Pleader for Services-I, appearing for the respondents. Perused the material on record.

3. The petitioner belongs to OC(W) category and completed B.Sc in 1998 and B.Ed in 2003. She applied for the post of SGT under DSC-2008 on 27.12.2008, mentioning her qualifications as B.Sc and B.Ed and not D.Ed. She received Acknowledgement Card No.762/27.12.2008 and Hall Ticket No.23200114944. In the written test held in May 2009, she secured 63 marks with Rank No.1138. As per G.O.Ms.No.28 dated 29.01.2009, 30% of the SGT posts were reserved for D.Ed candidates, which led to the filing of W.P.No.18683/2009, wherein the Court granted interim order on 09.09.2009 suspending the 30% rule. On 23.11.2010, the petitioner was informed that she was mistakenly considered as D.Ed candidate and was not entitled for appointment, as the last OC(W) candidate appointed under the 70% list had secured 64.5 marks. In November

2010, the respondents filled SGT vacancies, leaving 1800 posts unfilled. Subsequently, on 08.02.2024, the Court passed interim order in W.P.No.18683/2009 directing that B.Ed candidates be considered for appointment on a contract basis. On 26.09.2024, the petitioner clarified her qualifications and was asked to submit a representation due to a typographical error. Despite submission of the representation on 26.09.2024 to respondent No.2 and also another representation dated 26.09.2024 to respondent No.4, no action was taken. On 14.02.2025, under G.O.Ms.No.14, the respondents appointed B.Ed candidates with Ranks 1140, 1141, 1149, 1158, 1164, and 1166, but denied appointment to the petitioner, who had secured Rank No.1138. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner filed the present Writ Petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appropriate orders be passed in this Writ Petition, directing the respondents to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner on 26.09.2024 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with the law.

5. Learned Government Pleader for Services-I, appearing for the respondents, did not dispute the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, without going into the

merits of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 26.09.2024, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with the law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
